Questionnaire Feedback – February 2015

Questionnaires were delivered to every household in Cherhill, additionally the facility to complete the questionnaire online was available at www.cherhill.org.

In total **158** completed questionnaires were received. **125** respondents said they would like a new hall to have facilities for groups and societies, **115** wanted entertainment and event facilities, **109** wanted theatre, **96** wanted cinema, **92** wanted indoor sport, **89** exhibition facilities and **67** outdoor sport.

Over half the respondents, **87**, did not express any concerns about the Project. Most of those who did express concerns addressed matters arising from the development of a new hall, they did not express opposition to the idea itself. **17** respondents were concerned that adequate parking should be provided, **8** wanted traffic to be managed appropriately, **7** were interested in the re-development of the current hall, **5** addressed security of the new site, **5** the effect on neighbours, **4** mentioned attractive architecture and **4** the sensitivity of the location.

There were **15** responses which were objections to the project. As principal reasons for their objection **8** respondents cited the proposed location, **2** believed the Project was unnecessary, **2** cited cost and **2** the use of a new hall by non-residents.
